FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$200 to enter and \$200 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Thursday, March 25, 2004 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$40,000 Guaranteed plus \$10,000 KTDF for KTDF eligibles only. Monies to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 121 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over since December 5, allowed, 3 lbs.; \$25,000 twice at a mile or over since September 3, 5 lbs.; \$21,000 at a mile or over in 2004, 7 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/ Group stakes winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2003-2004. ANGELA'S LOVE sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace along the inside, repulsed a bid by SECONDARY SCHOOL entering the stretch and drew off under a brisk hand ride. SECONDARY SCHOOL pressed the pace off the inside, made a run at the winner approaching the stretch, was no match for that one in the drive while clearly second best. JARAMAR RAIN within striking distance three wide, tired in the stretch. SMALL PROMISES stumbled at the start, ducked in recovering to soundly bump POISON OAK CAMP, rushed inside into the first turn, moved out on the backstretch, held well for six furlongs and faded. STRIKE RATE within striking distance early along the inside, gave way. MARIAWORTH was no factor. POISON OAK CAMP bumped at the start, was outrun.
