COOL BULLET disputed the pace four wide, shook clear leaving the turn and widened through the drive. STRAPPING GROOM chased COOL BULLET to no avail five wide, but continued on well to clearly prove second best. ROCKIN' ROCKSTAR broke slowly, settled in hand, came six wide to make a late rally and was along for the show. LUCKY CHUCK angled in to save ground, finished with a belated rally but failed to seriously threaten. KERA'S KITTEN rushed to the lead off of the inside, contested the matter to the inside of the winner, but came up empty before going a half and retreated. PLUTONIUM was hustled along three deep while never far back, but drifted out leaving the turn and faded. JUSTAMATTEROFTIME was bumped at the start, dropped well back and was never a factor.
