DARBY'S CHARM sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside and drew off under steady handling.\. GYM KID three wide on the first turn wen closest to the winner, moved in a path before a half and held on for the place. SING SOFTLY outrun early, split rivals with a quarter mile to go but had no late bid. EMILY'S MARK forwardly placed off the inside, moved to the inside for the second turn and gave way in the drive. AFTERNOON DREAMS outrun early, was no threat. QUIET CHARM within striking distance inside, dropped back and moved out to be four wide on the second turn and faded. GALILEO'S STAR within striking distance off the inside, raced three wide out of the second turn and faded.
