GOOD OL HENRY pressed the pace outside the winner, was no match for that one in the stretch but held on well to be second best. POLITICAL CAT shuffled back at the start, recovered to race within striking distance three wide but had nothing left in the drive. SULTRY PLEASURE forwardly placed three wide, gave way in the drive. SIR DEREK close up along the inside, faded. BIG PINEY hesitated at the start and was outrun in the three path.
