ALLIE'S HOPE vied for the lead from the start, saved ground on the turn, raced CATCHMECAT into defeat after a half and drew off under steady urging. LEXI'S MOON outsprinted along the inside, came off the rail late on the turn and lodged a mild bid for the place. WHAT A FILLY LES outrun early three wide, advanced into the stretch, drifted in in midstretch and again in deep stretch and lacked a late bid. SERVANT OF ALL outrun early along the inside, came off the rail in the stretch, drifted in when WHAT A FILLY LES drifted in in midstretch then steadied in deep stretch when that same rival drifted in again. PACIFIC SPELL behind the leaders in the three path, tired. CATCHMECAT alternated for the lead off the inside and gave way. POPULAR PATRIOT was no factor in the three path. O'LEES WISH close up along the inside, steadied near the furlong marker when dropping back then stopped.
