GRACE'S MIRACLE tracked the pace two wide, took over leaving the second turn and drew away to score as the rider pleased. TREATY OF KADESH settled in hand four wide, finished with a steady advanced along was along for the place. ASIAN JOY set the pressured pace along the inside, but weakened entering the stretch and settled for the minor award. SILVER STEF was unhurried into stride, advanced between horses through the second turn, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. MISS CANDYMAKER was forwardly placed three wide for six furlongs and tired. MADAME DEFARGE bobbled at the start, was unhurried and tucked in to save ground but lacked a response when called upon.
