### Footnotes

RICH FIND closest to the pace in the three path, made a run at the leader entering the second turn, dropped back a bit, came again to challenge in midstretch and drew clear late. PLAID reserved along the inside, moved closer along the rail on the second turn, angled out approaching the furlong marker and lodged a mild bid to be up for the place. SECRET ROMANCE sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside, repulsed a bid by the winner on the second turn, held on well to inside the final furlong and weakened. REQUEST DENIED lost her footing early, raced within striking distance in the two path and lacked a late bid. REGAL CASE forwardly placed four wide, tired in the stretch. FRENCH ACCOUNT was outrun. DIAMONDS AND LACE tired three wide.
