Footnotes

TRICKLE DOWN, closest to the pace, bid on the backstretch, took over in upper stretch, drifted in with a sixteenth to go then drew clear. TRUE TO CLAIRE, outrun early, made a good move off the inside on the second turn, steadied when moving to the winner inside the final furlong then held the place. SYRIAN EMPRESS, within striking distance inside, was angled out bit for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. CATHY'S GLORY, outrun early, raced in the three path on the second turn and finished well late. ANGEL LIPS, within striking distance, raced three wide on the second turn and had nothing left in the drive. COUNTACH, forwardly placed, was three wide on the second turn and gave way stretch. WILE was outrun. QUILT sprinted clear, set the pace inside but faded in the stretch. SAVAGERY was no threat. LA JOYA, within striking distance early three wide, stopped and was outdistanced.
