MADAME QUEEN reserved early outside, moved up five wide on the turn, caught the leader with a furlong to go and proved best under pressure. REALLY GROOVY within striking distance, angled out three wide midway through the turn when advancing, challenged in upper stretch and held on gamely. RED HOT FLASH vied for the early lead outside rivals, moved in a bit on the turn, continued well to midstretch and tired. DASHING GIRL within striking distance, raced four wide into the turn and tired. DIAMOND PLATE forced the pace from the inside and gave way in the final furlong. INFAMOUS ANGEL close up early between rivals, faded.
