BOURBON MINT closest to the pace while off the inside, took over before a half, drew off on the second turn and was not menaced while under steady urging. DEVILLIOUS reserved early, raced four wide around the second turn, reached closest to the winner in upper stretch but lodged only a mild late bid to be second best. SYMPHONIC LADY outrun early along the inside, was no threat. ONDATOP forwardly placed, was three wide on the second turn and faded. MISS THE MARK was no factor. KERNITRE (GB) set the early pace and stopped.
