MR BIG SHOT outsprinted early, raced six wide with three furlongs to go and closed well to be clear late. HE'S PERFECT within striking distance four wide, lodged a mild bid for the place. THE RAG MAN closest to the pace three wide, challenged in midstretch and held on gamely. MAMBO'S SONG forwardly placed from the start, raced near the rail late on the turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but weakened. COMPLICATED JACK set the pace off the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. CHEROKEE AXE stumbled after the start, was bumped by LONG RIDE HOME in the initial furlong then was outrun six wide. MAJOR AWARD took up early when LONG RIDE HOME swerved in then was outrun. LONG RIDE HOME broke down early, swerved in, hit the inside rail unseating his rider.
