MARY THE SECOND (IRE), close up from the start while chasing front-running LAST BOAT EAST under light rating, raced four wide, took over from that one just after going six furlongs, edged clear between calls in the stretch, then lasted under pressure over MIMI'S GOLDEN GIRL. The latter, within easy striking distance while following the leaders in hand five wide, came out further to race six wide in the drive and finished willingly while too late. DANZIG MATILDA, outrun until the stretch, came out seven wide to advance and found her best stride late. LAST BOAT EAST gained the lead at once, raced in the three path, lost the lead to the winner a stride after going six furlongs and weakened thereafter. AUSTIN RUNNER, unhurried early, made a bid approaching the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. THREE THREES, well placed four wide to the stretch, faded thereafter. BEVIE'S PARTY, forwardly placed early along the inside, was finished at the far turn.
