**Footnotes**

SULTRY PLEASURE within striking distance four wide, challenged from the three path on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch and lasted late. QUICK COUNT forwardly placed three wide, split rivals angering the stretch then closed well late inside the winner. SLEW'S SUMMIT within striking distance five wide, moved to contention in that path on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. GENTLEMENARERARE unprepared at the start, was outrun early and improved his position while no threat. FLAGGER closest to the pace along the inside, challenged off the inside on the second turn, held well to the final furlong and tired. ZAMBLES could not menace. LYNN'S VISION set the pace, held on well to the stretch and faded. PIONEERING APPLE had speed for a half.
