BILLY'S BAND stalked the pace along the inside, got through and took over leaving the turn, shook off BARAT late and edged clear. BARAT vied between horses, continued on well but was unable to match strides with the winner late. BIG BLUE FEVER stalked the pace four wide, bid five wide between horses but lacked the needed late response. GOOD AND MAD circled seven wide, offered a mild bid leaving the turn but failed to sustain the drive. CAMPTON rushed to contention between horses, but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. DONTLOOKMEOVER was hustled along on the inside but was never a factor. JUST LIKE HARRY passed only the tiring ones. STORMIN LARRY set the pressured pace between horses, but was headed after a half and dropped out. MR. INVESTER broke awkwardly and showed little thereafter. WHAT A HEMI saved ground to no avail. VOYANT was through early. NATIVE CRY was allowed to settle, bore out entering the turn, was taken up and eased to the wire but walked off.
