Footnotes

GREAT RISK steadied on the first turn, angled out on the backstretch, moved up four wide on the second turn, challenged approaching the stretch and drew clear under steady urging. AERIAL STORM lost his footing at the start and steadied, was unhurried four wide, advanced five wide on the second turn and finished willingly to be up for the place. MOVE ON UP close up four wide, moved in a bit on the backstretch, gained a short lead approaching the stretch but weakened. WILDOMAR SPRINGS within striking distance five wide, moved in a path on the second turn while moving a bit closer but lacked a late bid. STRATEGIC DECISION forwardly placed three wide, had nothing left late. RIDE IN THE PARK five wide early, raced six wide on the second turn and failed to menace. YEMEN was outrun. SMOKIN FAST close up along the inside, faded in the final quarter. POWER PARTS set the pace off the inside, held on well to the final quarter and stopped.
