LADY BATES, never far back and saving ground from the start in behind the dueling leaders, came out and split foes five wide in the upper stretch, took over a sixteenth and drove clear under intermittent urging. SERVING MA MAN, knocked sideways at the start and outrun for a half, circled foes seven wide and finished with good energy. WALNUT SPRINGS went up to vie for the lead inside early, reached the front on the turn, held on well into deep stretch and faltered. KATHERINE ANN bore in badly at the start and slammed SERVING MA MAN, raced in contention for a half, bid five wide into the stretch but was empty in the final furlong. MISS DUSTY forced the pace three abreast into the stretch and tired. REBS TEMPTRESS saved ground to no avail. SONORA'S HERITAGE battled for the lead between foes into the stretch and tired.
