**Footnotes**

MISS BLUES SWEEP, forwardly placed from the beginning, stalked the leaders three wide, took over in the upper stretch, was clear between calls, then was hard ridden to last over TRICKLE DOWN. The latter, within striking distance, came out six wide for the drive and finished well. WISE ROMANCE, outrun for a half, saved ground, split foes four wide in deep stretch and also finished well. HAVERHOMBYMIDNITE gained the lead at once, raced a bit off the inside, showed the way into the stretch and weakened. MISS T J, in closed quarters soon after the start and outrun until the stretch, made a mild gain. LAUGH ABOUT, close up inside into the stretch, weakened when the test came. MISS NIKNAR, well placed four wide into the final furlong, came up empty. KEY ECHO, outrun until the stretch, angled seven wide for the drive but failed to seriously menace. BIG DEAL tired after a half. DESERT CLARITY was done early.
