HOMEM RA vied for the lead off the inside, took over on the turn and stayed clear under steady urging. ALYDELTA reserved along the inside, angled out entering the stretch and finished well. NEW KID IN TOWN behind the leaders along the inside, came off the rail for the drive but lacked a late bid. D. J. TYLER contested the pace along the inside and tired. SAINT GOLDDIGGER broke thru the starting gate an instant before the start, was outrun early, raced five wide late on the turn and was no threat. ROCKING TRICK (ARG) within striking distance outside NEW KID IN TOWN, held on well for nearly a half and gave way.
