ROLLER GIRL close up four wide, challenged late on the turn, dropped back a bit in midstretch then came again and edged off late. AVARICITY set the pace near the rail and held on gamely to be second best. HERE'S HOGAN outsprinted early, raced three wide on the turn and had no late bid. SWEET SANDY forwardly placed along the inside, tired. TRICK SHOT GAL prompted the pace between rivals and tired. COINCIDENCE was outrun. MISS IMAGINE THAT broke slowly, raced four wide on the turn and was no threat. SASSY TRISHA within striking distance, angled in to the two path entering the turn and faded. NEW KINDA WALK was no threat.
