Footnotes

RICHWOOD GOLD outrun early four wide, moved out six wide leaving the turn then rallying and closed well to be up in time. EIGHT EIGHTY EIGHT in close quarters early, recovered to race within striking distance, advanced four wide into the stretch, wore down the leader but missed. MISS BROOKLYN B alternated for the lead three wide and weakened late. MAMBO ROSE close up along the inside, lacked a closing bid. BANYAN STREET outperformed early along the inside, was no threat. MS. BLUE BLOOD prominent five wide, tired. AWSUGAHNOW was no factor. TEXAS AMBASSADOR drifted in after the start and was outrun three wide. JAMIE'S MAMBO close up four wide, gave way. REBALITE vied for the lead off the inside and faded. SHESANICELADY could not menace.
