TRUMPS NATIVE LADY reserved near the rail, angled out five wide late on the turn, challenged inside the final furlong and drew clear. MAID'S FOLLY within striking distance, commenced her rally five wide midway through the turn, challenged in upper stretch, took over with a furlong to go but was no match for the winner late. WAVERLY GOLD outrun early, raced four wide on the turn when advancing then closed well late. PRINCESS IRIS vied for the lead off the inside, angled out a bit farther late on the turn but tired late. MARZI forced the pace four wide and tired in the final furlong. BARGAIN BETTY close up along the inside, gave way in the stretch. CHEROKEE KELLY within striking distance in the three path, faded. CERTIFIED APPROVAL vied for the lead three wide, held on well to the stretch and was through. PENNY POINT was outrun while off the inside.
