K. C.'S GIFT vied for the early lead along the inside, dropped back before a half, was pocketed into the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and finished with a late burst of speed to be up in time. CURVE AHEAD forced the early pace between rivals, stopped back before a half, angled out, moved to challenge four wide on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch but missed. MT. BONSI with the early pace four wide, angled in a bit on the backstretch, continued well to the quarter mile marker and tired. KATIE MY LADY alternated for the lead three wide, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the second turn and gave way in the stretch. DISCO LADY five wide early when forwardly placed, angled in to the three path midway through the first turn, challenged with a half mile to go but faded in the drive. WEEKEND GOLD six wide into the first turn when prominent, angled to the rail soon after, moved out four wide entering the second turn and faded. TEMERITY PLUS was outrun.
