SKYTREK pressed the pace, took over in late stretch but could not hold off the winner and was outfinished. FIVE STAR DAWN swerved in out at the start bumping two rivals, then went up into a hole that did not exist and was shut off and had no late gain. WEATHER WARNING showed good speed from inside to deep stretch but faltered in the late going. IFONLYJOHNNY never far back to stretch could go on and faded late. ROCKHOUSE ROCKET failed to menace. LEMON DROP HIGH bumped after the start then no factor.
