WAR ROMANCE outrun early, made a run five wide on the turn and closed well to be up in time. HESMYTEMPTATION within striking distance off the inside, challenged after a half, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but was outfinished. WEST COAST GREY forced the pace near rail, took over, swerved out in upper stretch and weakened. FIVE VICES with the leaders four wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. BIMINI STORM alternated for the lead off the inside and faded. TOCCTIVE BOY prompted the pace three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. TACTICAL FORCE was outrun six wide.
