LUCKY SASS vied for the lead four wide, drifted to the inside in midstretch and moved clear. LORD DUBAI forced the pace three wide, steadied when the winner drifted to the rail then held on for the place. ROCKSLIDE SLIM behind the leaders in the four path, lacked the needed closing bid. MO' TERMS outrun early, raced seven wide into the turn then lodged a mild late bid. MR. BRUTUS forced the pace between rivals and tired. SEVEN SUMMITS outrun early, steadied approaching the stretch then made a late gain. EL SKIPPO contested the pace along the inside and tired. JEMARU outrun along the inside, could not menace. CENTARUS was no factor. MATTY MAN was no threat. HAP E TYPE faded along the inside.
