Footnotes

LIGHT SABRE tracked the leaders from the rail, reached a striking position in the late going and responded well when asked to advance along the rail. SMITTY sprinted from the start to press the issue, battled outside a pair of foes along the backstretch, prevailed to take a lead into the deep stretch but was caught in the final going. C. I. EDDIE raced at the front of a three horse battle while between foes, was in contention through the stretch but yielded. A SHOT AT LOVE tracked the battle for the lead from the inside, swung four or five wide out of the turn for his run but flattened out. TOWARD THE MARK raced near the middle of the field for the opening half, swung out six or seven wide and lacked a response. ALPINE THUNDER passed tiring foes. WINNING WELL raced four wide and failed to offer a late bid. STORMIN' EDGE raced in good position in the opening quarter and tired. GIVEN COMMAND was outrun.
