Footnotes

FOMO showed early speed to quickly gain the advantage then held sway to the wire. SOUTHERN BLING was fractious at the gate, broke well and was allowed to settle, raced near mid pack to the turn, circled the field in the lane and was gaining late. ZARYNA was reserved while racing in good position near mid pack, rallied on the outside and closed willingly. ZARCH reared at the start and trailed the field, moved up between horses and finished well. ENDURING HEART raced along the two or three path while towards the rear and finished evenly. AREQUIPA was always in contact while racing on the inside near mid pack but lacked a late run. ROWDY STELLA was close to the pace in the early going while racing in the three path and faded late. JEAN'S MEMORY pressed the pace in the opening half then tired shortly thereafter.
