ANGELS CAN BE WILD was unhurried early while saving ground, rallied on the second turn and got through along the rail, drew off under constant handling. FRENCH CHEW was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. DAKOTA DIM was unhurried early while on the outside, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. FLYAWAY BABY was unhurried early while seven wide and lost ground, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. INTENTIONAL pressed the pace early, rallied on the backstretch and led, weakened in the stretch and faded. ZIPPY CARLIE JOE was well placed while four wide, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back. REFINED SILK failed to menace. MORINSTORE set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back.
