Footnotes

SHOE QUEEN set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged before a half, drew clear into the stretch and stayed clear under steady urging. BE A QUIET HONEY angled out three wide on the first turn when forwardly placed, challenged before a half then continued gamely to the finish. HOUNDING forced the pace off the inside and tired in the final furlong. BOUNTY'S FREEDOM outrun early, made a run four wide on the second turn but was no real threat. NO MERCY unhurried early, could not menace. AVIDLY CONNECTED reserved early, made a mild move along the inside after six furlongs but had no late bid. KLASS TO BURN was no threat. MS EASTER LILLY was outrun. JUST CALL ME IRISH within striking distance three wide, stopped. RAISING THE FLAG close up while off the inside, stopped.
