QUINCY MARKET sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside and stayed clear under steady urging. VIVALADIVA six wide into the first turn, angled in a bit, advanced four wide after five furlongs and finished willingly late. THE RIGHT PEW closest to the pace while off the inside, tired in the stretch. BLABBY B. forwardly placed while four wide early, faded in the stretch. CABALLO NOBILE angled in early when within striking distance, gave way after 6 furlongs. VAL U ME five wide into the first turn, was no real threat. COOL GHOUL forwardly placed three in the three path, faded. ANITA PRINCE was outrun. LAMBKINS was outrun.
