Footnotes

DANCE DANCE six wide on the first turn, made a quick move on the backstretch to a forward position, challenged from the four path on the second turn, took over and stayed clear under steady urging. SAVANNAH'S PRIZE within striking distance, angled out three wide leaving the second turn and closed well late. IDELIKEATOY five wide on the first turn when within striking distance, dropped back a bit and angled in once on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the second turn and rallied willingly late. SYL D'OR outrun early, raced five wide on the second turn and made some late gain. ELECTRIC STAR sent up along the inside to vie for the lead, held on well to midstretch and weakened. AZOOMA four wide early when behind the leaders, angled in and saved ground on the second turn but had no late bid. CALL ME MEG outrun early, was no factor. DASHING GIRL contested the pace in the two path and faded in the stretch. OCTOBER OPTIMIST prompted the pace three wide and stopped.
