### Footnotes

POMEROY closest to the pace while off the inside, challenged after a half, gained a short lead entering the second turn, swerved out in upper stretch, opened a clear lead soon after then lasted when tiring late. MR. JESTER reserved early three wide, made a bold middle move in company with THE CLIFF'S EDGE, could not keep pace with that one with three furlongs to go, drifted five wide approaching the stretch, angled in a bit, bumped with PROPER PRADE in midstretch then finished willingly inside POMEROY to just miss. THE CLIFF'S EDGE broke in the air, was outrun early, made a bold five wide move into the second turn, made a run at the leaders midway through that turn, steadied when POMEROY swerved out in upper stretch, then held on gamely to the finish. PROPER PRADO outrun early three wide, advanced off the inside on the second turn, came out four wide approaching the stretch, bumped with MR. JESTER in midstretch then rallied willingly late. BOGANGLES four wide on the first turn when within striking distance, weakened in the final quarter. BUSTIN' OUT bumped with GOLDEN TONES at the start, sprinted clear, set the pace near the inside and gave way in the drive. RAVADON unhurried early along the inside, was no factor. GOLDEN TONES bumped at the start, was forwardly placed, stopped after five furlongs and was vanned off. Following a foul claim by the rider of THE CLIFF'S EDGE against the rider of the winner, POMEROY was disqualified and placed third for interference in the stretch.
