Footnotes

CAJUN BEAT closest to the pace in the three path, challenged on the turn, drew clear into the stretch then lasted late. CLOCK STOPPER outrun early, advanced three wide on the turn, steadied in upper stretch when blocked, split horses with a furlong to go and closed well late. CHAMPALI forwardly placed six wide, held on well in the stretch. OZZIE CAT outrun early, angled out four wide with three furlongs to go then made a good late bid. GOLD STORM forwardly placed four wide, lacked a late bid. COMIC TRUTH outrun early, was five wide with three furlongs to go and finished well. FIFTEEN ROUNDS within striking distance, saved ground on the turn and had nothing left in the stretch. SKEET in tight early, prompted the pace four wide and tired. OFFLEE WILD within striking distance early in the three path, faded. COACH JIMI LEE was no threat. CAT GENIUS set the early pace out in the strip, angled in to the two path on the turn and faded in the drive.
