BUDGE MAN close up off the rail, angled out on the second turn, made a bold five wide move approaching the stretch, bumped with BROKERAGE HOUSE in upper stretch, drew clear inside the final furlong and lasted late. STRATOSTAR within striking distance, dropped back after a half, raced four wide on the second turn, angled out for the drive and closed well. BROKERAGE HOUSE never far back four wide, challenged five wide on the second turn, bumped with the winner in upper stretch and weakened. OUTTA TUNE vied for the lead while off the rail and in hand but tired late. RAHYSTRADA pressed the pace four wide and tired. SAY IT SON pulled the rider to battle for the lead four wide, contested the pace in hand to the final quarter and gave way.
