SISTER GENEVRA set the pace inside, responded when headed before a half, responded again in the stretch and drew off under steady urging. SAVANNAH'S GLORY forwardly placed from the start, challenged three wide on the second turn but was no match for the winner late. KITALPHA CAT bobbled after the start, recovered to race within striking distance, challenged four wide on the second turn but tired in the drive. WINTER'S CHILD close up along the inside, also tired. LIMEHOUSE LEZA four wide with three furlongs, could not menace. JONES ZING was outrun. SOME GIVEN LEGEND forced the pace off the inside, gained a short lead before a half but stopped after five furlongs.
