This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters with no also-eligible list. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Footnotes

VINDICATION broke in the air, was outrun early, made a bold five wide move after five furlongs, caught the leaders with a quarter mile to go and drew off in the drive under steady handling. PRIVATE GOLD vied for the early lead inside, opened a comfortable lead before a half, responded willingly when displaced by BOSTON PARK midway through the second turn, came again in upper stretch, was in tight inside a loose horse with a furlong to go then dug in the final sixteenth to hold the place. TITO'S BEAU within striking distance early off the inside, made a mild move three wide on the second turn, angled out once in the stretch and improved his position late. CAPTAIN AMOUR close up early outside PRIVATE GOLD, steadied approaching the backstretch when in tight inside a loose hose, dropped back a bit, made a mild gain in the two path on the second turn but lacked a late bid. WINAPRIZE outrun early inside, angled out, raced three wide on the second turn, angled outside for the drive and finished willingly. BOSTON PARK carried four wide entering the first turn by a loose horse, recovered to be a forward factor, bid after five furlongs, gained a short lead four wide midway through the second turn but tired in the drive. RAPID PROOF outrun early, raced four wide on the second turn and was no factor. CROWNED KING stumbled at the start unseating his rider.
