Preference to start will be given to those horses having been assigned the highest weight (scale considered). Total 2002 earnings will be used in determining order of preference for horses assigned equal weights (scale considered). In addition no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. Closed Wednesday, September 4, 2002, with 25 nominations.

PURE PRIZE behind the leaders while kept off the rail, moved up four wide after six furlongs, caught the leaders entering the stretch, drew clear inside the final furlong and lasted under pressure. DOLLAR BILL outrun early, advanced three wide after six furlongs, came out a bit wider for the drive and closed well to be rapidly getting to the winner late. HERO'S TRIBUTE within striking distance in the four path, moved closer on the second turn but lacked a late bid. ABREEZE stumbled at the start, made a quick recovery, vied for the lead on the rail, came off the inside on the backstretch, raced in the two path on the second turn while continuing to battle for the lead but tired in the final furlong. NOTHING FLAT outrun early along the inside, made a mild gain into the stretch but went evenly late. THERE'S ZEALOUS alternated for the lead in the two path, raced three wide around the second turn while dueling with ABREEZE then tired in the final furlong. WOODMOON reserved early three wide, was no threat. MINER'S PRIZE angled out four wide on the first turn, w as unhurried early and was no factor.
