WHAT A BAD DAY behind the leaders three wide, challenged with a furlong to go and drew off under steady urging. ALKE vied for the lead along the inside and outfinished WOKE UP DREAMIN for the place. WOKE UP DREAMIN forced the pace while off the inside and tired in the final furlong. CAPTAIN FANTASTIC never far back while off the inside, tired. FEDERALE unhurried early, raced four wide on the turn and was no threat. ORVILLE FOREST outrun early, raced five wide and was no factor. STAUNTON was outrun. MADE FOR TAYLOR within striking distance in the four path, faded. CARDIAC ARREST was no factor. ONE FINE WINE was though early along the inside.
