FOR FILLIES, TWO-YEARS-OLD. By subscription of \$100, \$500 to enter and \$500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry Thursday, September 12, 2002 by payment of \$5,000 each. Weight 120 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Stake allowed 2 lbs.; of a non-graded stake, 4 lbs.; of two races other than claiming, 6 lbs.; a race other than claiming, 8 lbs. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters with no also-eligible list. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings. In addition no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. Closed Wednesday, September 4, 2002 with 27 nominations.

ATLANTIC OCEAN close up early while four wide, moved closer before a half, challenged on the second turn, raced GLORIOUS MISS into defeat in upper stretch, drew clear then stayed clear under steady urging. RUBY'S RECEPTION within striking distance early near the rail, dropped back on the backstretch, raced three wide on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and made a good late gain to be up for the place. JODY'S DEELITE pressed the pace while three wide and between rivals, moved in a bit on the second turn then weakened in the drive. WESTERLY BREEZE within striking distance four wide, made a mild gain four wide on the second turn but had no late bid. GLORIOUS MISS vied for the lead between rivals, moved to the inside on the second turn when engaged with the winner, could not stay with that one in upper stretch, angled out with a furlong to go and tired. MYMICH outrun early, made a good middle move off the rail, angled out for the drive but had no late bid. DANCE HALL GIRL vied for the lead along the inside and tired after a half. DEVIL AT THE WIRE outrun early, was no factor.
