ANY GIVEN SATURDAY well back early, made a six wide run on the turn and closed well to be up in the final stride. WESTWON behind the leaders, advanced fur wide on the turn to challenge, took over in midstretch but missed. BRILLIANT BID within striking distance, made a good move in the five path on the turn but hung late. BIG CHIEF broke in the air then was carried out after recovering, angled in, saved ground on the turn, angled out for the drive but had no late bid. DON'TWAIT TOOLONG far back to the stretch, rallied belatedly. LISSELAN RIGHTCALL close up along the inside, tired. ESPOOF drifted out at the start, vied for the lead along the inside and tired. WIT AND WISDOM drifted out at the start and was no threat. SOLO CONCERTO drifted out at the start then tired while off the inside. BAR HARBOR alternated for the lead off the inside and faded. T. BEAMER pressed the pace in the three path and faded.
