Footnotes

MISS PICKUMS a forward factor off the inside, dropped back a bit before a half, came again three wide entering the stretch, gained a short lead with a furlong to go, ducked in approaching the sixteenth marker when clear then held WARRUN safe late. WARRUN outrun early, angled out six wide with three furlongs to go, made a good gain to the furlong marker but hung late. ZONK unhurried early, advanced four wide into the second turn, bid after six furlongs but weakened late. OUT OF SYNC reserved early, moved out five wide near the three furlong marker when making a mild gain but had no late bid. CURVE AHEAD vied for the lead off the inside, held well to midstretch and tired. LADY ANDROMEDA within striking distance along the inside, tired in the stretch. LAKENHEATH outrun early, was no factor. ONE TOUGH CAT unhurried early, was no threat. COPEWITHTHISCOYOTE prompted the pace from the inside, stayed well for six furlongs and faded. DRESSED IN GOLD pressed the early pace while four wide on the first turn and stopped. ORPHAN INDY was outrun. COCKTAIL SAUCE five wide on the first turn when moving to a forward position, challenged before a half but stopped after five furlongs.
