### Footnotes

MY BUDDY BUBBA was in a good stalking position while on the inside, rallied into the stretch and got through along the rail, began to draw clear and was all out to hold on late. OUR KING dueled for the lead and set the pace while off the rail, drew off on the backstretch, came again late grudgingly. WEEKEND PASS was unhurried early, rallied on the second turn and was wide, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. SUNBURST was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. GOT SEOUL was void of early speed, had a mild late rally. BELLEOFTHEVALLEY showed good early speed chasing the pace while six wide, faltered and faded. MY BUDDY GARFIELD failed to menace. CATARIAT was no threat. MILL POINT dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, stopped and dropped back.
