NINETY FIVE SOUTH lagged back to the turn, came five wide past the quarter pole, rallied and drew clear in the stretch. BATON ROUGE showed good speed to the front, stayed well to deep stretch but run down late. TANNER ME BOY lunged at the start and pinched back, made an inside run with a bid past the quarter pole but flattened out in the drive. COSIMO raced four wide most of way, stayed wide into the stretch with no late bid. BILL HARV RIB well placed and never far back, lacked a late response when called upon. DON'TGETMADGETEVEN raced evenly while no serious threat. MASS was never a menace. KATZMETIC stayed up close from outside to the turn but faded in the stretch run. GALLANT never a threat. CITIZEN pressed the pace early but stopped readily.
