Monies to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 120 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Stake allowed 2 lbs.; of a non-graded stake, 4 lbs.; of two races other than claiming, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Footnotes

GREATER GOOD far back early along the inside, made a run three wide on the second turn, angled out in upper stretch and closed fast to win going away. MAGNA GRADUATE set the early pace off the inside, moved to the rail and opened a clear lead on the second turn, drifted out a bit near the furlong marker when the winner was moving to challenge, could not stay with that one late but was clearly second best. NORAINONTHISPARTY outrun early in the two path, made a solid middle move, angled out for clear room in upper stretch but had no late bid. UNITED close up along the inside, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. STORIED CAT pressed the pace three wide, moved in a bit after a half, held well to the stretch and gave way in the drive. SEQUOIA GROVE forwardly placed four wide, stayed in that path on the second turn and faded.
