SOLID PLATINUM reserved four wide, advanced into the stretch and closed well to be up in time. SPEEDY SUNRISE forwardly placed in the three path, challenged on the turn, drew clear in midstretch but was outfinished. QUITE A RUCKUS close up, raced in the three path on the turn and lacked a closing bid. FAT CHANTS within striking distance four wide, lacked a closing bid and finished on even terms with WOULD YOU BE MINE. WOULD YOU BE MINE unhurried early, raced in the four path on the turn and had little left late to dead heat FAT CHANTS. FACTORY REJECT outrun early, made a late gain. PAPA SIDES GIRL could not menace. BOSTON STORM set the pace off the inside and gave way in the drive. YOUNITY five wide on the turn, was no factor. CROSSFIELD had speed for a half. SATIABLE was outrun.
