BLUE CHERRIES SPIN closest to the pace five wide, challenged after three furlongs, drew clear in midstretch then stayed clear while kept to the task. RICHER GEAR within striking distance five wide, lodged a mild bid for the place. DA DA DA DUM close up three wide, lacked a rally. HOLBORN set the pace while kept out in the four path, held on well to midstretch and tired. DIAMOND MAGIC unhurried six wide, failed to respond in the final furlong. ELUSIVE HERO within striking distance six wide, gave way.
