PASSPORT unhurried four wide, advanced four wide on the second turn, caught the leader with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. PETION STATION vied for the lead off the inside, could not stay with the winner late but held the place. LUMBERJACK CAT outrun early, advanced off the inside approaching the stretch and made a late gain. C J'S MISSILE reserved early four wide, was no real threat. SMART SHERIF forced the pace three wide, held on well to the stretch and gave way. AMERICA'S BEST was outrun. CRAFTY MARK bumped at the start, recovered to be forwardly placed along the inside but faded. INDIANTOWN JONES bumped CRAFTY MARK at the start, raced behind the leaders three wide and faded.
