GOOD MORNING NELL reserved early, made a five wide run on the turn, challenged in midstretch and drew clear under steady urging. MISS GRAND unhurried early, made a good five wide move entering the stretch and finished willingly to be second best. TED'S DREAM close up early, dropped back on the turn, angled out six wide approaching the stretch and came again late. ELLE BELLE unhurried four wide, lacked the needed late bid. HOWABOUTTHEMHEELS far back early, rallied belatedly. I COPY outspurred early, drifted nine wide leaving the turn and improved her position late. MISS SHARONA sprinted clear, set the pace in the three path and tired in the final furlong. HAYLEIGH CAT within striking distance for a half, gave way. FAR LEFT closest to the pace, raced near the rail on the turn, made a run at the leader before a half but faded in the drive. OKLAHOMA HEAT broke slowly, rushed inside, moved off the rail on the turn and stopped.
