CODOY forwardly placed four wide, challenged on the second turn and proved best late. HAZARDS OF LOVE closest to the pace, challenged three wide entering the second turn and held on gamely to the finish. STAY PUT reserved early, made a solid four wide middle move but lodged only a mild late bid. SOUTHERN CAUSEWAY within striking distance, raced in the three path on the second turn and weakened in the drive. CHEF ERIC outrun to the stretch, improved his position while no threat. RIVER OAKS outrun early, could not menace. BABY AFLEET forwardly placed along the inside, angled out on the second turn and tired. ON THE AIR was no factor. SUPRAMAN within striking distance between rivals, steadied near the half mile marker then faded in the drive. BRIGHT PRINCE set the early pace, held on well to the second turn and faded.
