DIRECTIVE vied for the lead off the inside, moved to the rail on the second turn, drew off into the stretch and was not menaced while kept to the task. TERRI'S CHARMER forced the early pace inside the winner, dropped back a bit before a half then was coming again late. MINER'S MEADOW never far back four wide, made a run at the winner on the second turn but tired in the drive. PAY THE TOLL five wide early when within striking distance, moved in to the three path on the second turn when forwardly placed but tired in the drive. GOTTALOTTACHARM pressed the early pace three wide and gave way. HEAVENLY OIL was no threat. SPRING JABAR was outrun. DANDELION SUMMER could not menace. LINK TO THE MOON four wide early, faded after a half. DENALI RED steadied behind the leaders late on the first turn when the saddle slipped, steadily dropped back and was eased.
